Through interactive techniques such as simple conversational drills, storytelling, role-play, group discussions, recitation of subhāṣitas, vocabulary-building games, and guided reading of easy Sanskrit texts, the programme helps create a classroom environment in which Sanskrit becomes a living and enjoyable language.
